



## NUTWOOD OBSERVATORY

This 2,000-acre observatory and wildlife sanctuary is an astronomer's paradise!

One thing that you'll have to see in person to appreciate is the dark sky available in Bancroft and surrounding area. The rating on the Sky Quality Meter (SQM) is 21.0 and that's about as good as it gets anywhere!

The property owner Brian, an avid science buff, invites you to explore the night sky and has the proper equipment to do so which included a 12x12-foot guest observatory, 16-inch Sky-Watcher computerized Go-To scope, and binocular-equipped refractor. For those with an interest in astro-imaging there is also a 16-foot motorized dome in which a 14-inch Ceravolo Astrograph that resides along with a host of computers and monitors for image processing as well.
